




- A-Remote sensor

- **-** DC power input port



Note: Only use the original power adapter. Using different types of power adapter may cause damage to the digital photo frame.


1.3 Installation




a) Insert the bracket into the product on the back

c) Connect power adapter to the product.




 d) Connect the DC power adapter to power socket.

3 Getting Started

3.1 Main Menu

Once powered on, the main menu will appear after a few seconds. If an EMMC card or USB flash drive is plugged in, the slide will automatically start playing its picture.

You can return to the main menu by pressing MENU button.

► Calendar View photos within a calendar

► Setup Configure the settings for your Digital Frame

► Enter To select an option

▶ Photo Play photo (Note: To achieve the best viewing, you can convert

photos to original ratio view.)

► Music Play music► Movie Play movie► Rotate Rotate photo

3.2 Media Playing

Insert a SD Card or USB Stick into the side of your Digital Frame. Once the frame successfully reads your media device, it will play your photos immediately.

You can select the media you want to play from the menu or press the button on remote directly. (No content will be played if no card inserted.)

Play all photos All JPEG photos will be played


Play all videos All videos will be played

Browse Search for photos and videos you want to play


3.3 Calendar

To view the calendar, select the Calendar icon from the main menu. You can set up the data and time in setting menu, then the information displayed will be correct.




4 Settings Menu


In the setting page, press "up" or "down" to choose setup items and "left" or "right" to choose options.

6. Troubleshooting

Q: Why can't my Digital Frame turn on?

If you suspect that the power adapter is not working, contact us at service@dbpower.co.uk and we will send you a new one.

Q: The slide show sometimes freezes on a certain Photo or Video.

Occasionally the frame gets stuck on a photo or video. First of all, make sure you are playing compatible files only. The photo or video might have been edited or saved in a manner which is not fully compatible with the frame's processor. You might need to optimize your content for smooth slides show playback.

Q: Why are some of my Photos the wrong way round?

Some photos are not appearing in the correct orientation. The usual reason for this is that the original files as taken on the camera are this way inclined. Check them on the capturing device again to see if this is the case. If they were rotated on something like Windows Explorer, they will not have actually saved in the new orientation for the Digital Photo Frame to recognize this.

Q: Why my USB flash drive or SD / SDHC card cannot be read?

Check if the USB flash drive or SD / SDHC card is inserted correctly Notches should be face down. Do not force the memory Card in. The maximum capacity of USB flash drive or SD / SDHC card should not exceed 32GB.

Q: Why is my Remote Control not working properly?

If the Remote Control is new, firstly make sure you have removed the plastic tab from between the battery and the tray. Now make sure you are pointing the Remote Control towards the Remote Sensor and you are pressing the buttons slowly. If you suspect the battery is flat, you will need to replace it with a CR2025 lithium button-cell battery. If you suspect that the Remote Control is not working at all, please email us and we will send you a new one.

7. Warranty

8. Safety

8.1 Notes of Importance

- ► Never remove a Memory Card or USB Flash Drive from a Digital Photo Frame whilst any media is playing or being deleted.
- ► Always keep a back up of your photos!
- Your warranty does not cover damage caused by incorrect use of memory devices.

8.2 Important Safety Information

Always follow the basic safety precautions when using your **TENKER** Digital Frame This Will reduce the risk of fire, electric shock, product damage and personal Injury.

- ▶ Do not block ventilation openings. Slots and openings on the Digital Frame are provided for ventilation. The openings should never be blocked by placing your Digital Frame on a cushion, sofa or other similar surface.
- Keep the Digital Frame away from direct sunlight and heat sources such as radiators or stoves.
- ▶ Never place heavy or sharp objects on the LCD panel or Digital Frame.
- ▶ Do not place the Digital Frame on an unstable cart, stand, tripod, bracket or table. Only use the AC adapter included with the Digital Frame. Using any other adapter will void your warranty.

▶ Protect the power cord from being walked on or pinched particularly at plugs, receptacles and the point where the cord attaches to the Digital Frame.

8.3 WARNING



To reduce the risk of electric shock, do not remove the cover or back of the unit. There are no user-serviceable parts inside. Please refer servicing to qualified personnel.



To prevent fire or electric shock hazard, do not expose the Digital Frame to rain, moisture or water(dripping or splashing).



Objects filled with liquids, such as vases, should not be placed near the Digital Frame.
