


1.6 WARRANTY EXCEPTIONS







The battery, two side brushes and filter assembly are in the main body.

PRODUCT INSTALLATION

PLEASE INSTALL THE BATTERY BEFORE USING THE CLEANER



- Connect the terminal of the battery pack with the machine; then press the battery pack downwards into the battery compartment.
- Please put the docking station on flat ground against a wall. Clear away dust and other debris before placing the docking station on the floor. Next, insert the adapter into.

Tips:

The docking station can't be placed on carpet. It is recommended to place it in a fixed position and do not regularly move it. Please don't move the docking station during cleaning.



- Place the docking station on flat ground against a wall. Make sure no obstacles are present within 3 meters of the front of the docking station or within 1 meter's scope of it.
- 2. Connect the adapter and docking station.



4.1.2 WORK MODE

4.1.2.1 Manual Mode



Short-press the Power key and the indicator will light up. The cleaner will enter standby state, and then start cleaning automatically.




 When the vacuum cleaner is in standby state, press the Power key and it will become active. The Recharge key will flash blue and the device will find the docking station.

4.1.3 Guide to operating indicators

4.2 CHARGING METHODS

4.2.1 Manual Charging





1. Charging with the docking station:

Connect the adapter to the docking station first, and then insert to the power supply; place the vacuum cleaner on the docking station for charging. (The blue indicator of the recharge key will flash during the recharge; the blue indicator will be on all the time after the device is fully charged).

2. Charging via the remote control:

When the cleaner is at the standby state, press the "recharge" button to let the machine enter the recharge mode.

4.2.2 Auto Charging



Automatic Charging:

When the working voltage is below 13V, the blue indicator of the recharge key will flash and the device will enter the recharge mode.

Tips:

- Users should operate the remote control within 7 meters' distance of the cleaner.
- When pressing the "auto-recharge" button, the vacuum cleaner may fail to return to the charging station if there are complex surrounding obstacles or if the cleaner runs out of battery power.

Start/Stop (button)	When the cleaner is in standby mode, press the button to enter the auto-cleaning mid. When the cleaner is at any cleaning mode, press the button to let it shift to standby mode. After finishing the sweeping task it automatically turns into recharging mode. When settling the time, press this button to hold settlings. The cleaner will respond with a sound when receiving an order from the remote corr		
Forward button	Long-press the button and the cleaner will forward; releasing, it stops moving.		
Left-turn button	Long-press the button and the cleaner rotates counterclockwise; releasing, it stops.		
Right-turn button	Long-press the button and the cleaner rotates clockwise; releasing, it stops rotating.		
Back button	Long-press the button and the cleaner moves backward; releasing, it stops moving,		
Auto Cleaning button	Press the button to change the cleaner's cleaning state to standby. When the cleaner is standby, press the button to left shift to auto cleaning mode. After finishing the severaling will turns into rechanging mode.		
Edge Cleaning button	Press the button to change the cleaner's cleaning state to standby. When the cleaner is standby, press the button to let it shift to edge cleaning mode. After finishing the sweeping task it automatically turns into nechanging mode. The cleaner will respond with a sound when receiving an order from the remote control,		
Single Room Cleaning button	Press the button to change the cleaner's cleaning state to standby. When the cleaner is standby, press the button to left shift to single-room cleaning mode. After finishing the sweeping task it automatically turns into recharging mode. The cleaner will respond with a sound when receiving an order from the remote control.		
Button of time-setting	In the standby state pressing this button, the " ♠ "and" BB: " on the disptay screen will flash. Then press the up (down key to adjust the hour. 2. Press the leftright-flum key " ◀ " and " ▶ " to change into " : BB " to adjust the minute. 3. Please save your settings by pressing the " ▶ II" or " ♠ ". The cleaner will respond with a sound when receiving an order from the remote control.		
Button of scheduling to clean	1. In the standby state pressing this button, the "		
Button of recharging	In the cleaning mode, press the button to change the vacuum cleaner into standby. In the standby mode, press the button to let it do in recharging mode. The cleaner will respond with a sound when receiving an order from the remote control.		

Note:

If the remote control fails to respond, please check whether the batteries need replacing. If you still can't operate the cleaner after charging, then re-pair with the cleaner again.

TEPS TO RESET THE REMOTE CONTROL:

A. Keep the cleaner in the standby mode.

B. Press the "Power" button of the cleaner.

C. Wait for 6 seconds and the machine will reset its code. The power indicator will flash.

D. Press the "" button, then release the key. When you hear the "didi" sound, the pairing process is finished.

REMARKS:

If you do not hear the "didi" sound, it means the pairing operation has failed. Please repeat the above procedures.






PRODUCT MAINTENANCE

5.1 DAILY STORAGE



If the cleaner will not be used for a long time, please fully charge the battery first and then store it in a dry place.

5.2 CLEANING OF CHARGING PLATE



Please turn off the power switch or disconnect the power plug first.

Please clean the charging plate monthly with dry cloth.

Do not use oil for scrubbing.

5.3 CLEAN THE DUST BOX

5.3.1 Assembly and Disassembly of Dust box



Press and hold the dust box button and then take out the dust box.

. 5.3.2 CLEANING THE DUST BOX



Open the baffle first, and then pour out the dust. Recommendation: the dustbin should be cleaned periodically.



Please clean the dustbin with the cleaning brush.



After taking out the filter, wipe off the dust with the cleaning brush.





 The dust box can be washed. (Note: the dust box should be completely air-dried before re-inserting).




After cleaning, re-assemble the filter in the dustbin first, and then install the dustbin into the cleaner.

• 5.4 CLEANING THE MAIN BRUSH

5.4.1 Disassembling the Main Brush





- Push the locking-bar buckle and lift it upward.
- 2. Clutch the main brush and lift it upward.



Take out the middle brushes and its scraper assembly.

5.4.2 Cleaning the main brush and the rubber brush



- Please clean the main brush and rubber brush with the cleaning brush regularly.
- 2. Please remove hair and other entanglements on the main brush regularly.

• 5.5 CLEANING THE SIDE BRUSH



 Unscrew the screws on the side brush with a screwdriver.



Remove the side brush and clear hair and debris from the inside of the cell.

. 5.6 CLEANING THE WHEELS



Clean the front, left and right wheels regularly with a cleaning brush.

• 5.7 CLEANING THE SENSORS



Ground Monitoring Sensor

Each time after cleaning is complete, use a dry cotton cloth to dry the transparent plate to prevent dust from being accumulated on it which may affect the performance of this product.



COMMON FAULTS

Error-flash indicator	Fault Names	Fault Forms	Solutions
Blue light flashes twice with one sound	Failure of left wheel	The left wheel doesn't rotate and is overloaded.	Please check if there are twisters on the left wheel of the device.
Blue light flashes three times with one sound	Failure of right wheel	The right wheel doesn't rotate and is overloaded.	Please check if there are twisters on the right wheel of the device.
Blue light flashes four times with one sound	Failure of device moving	The device moves and stops after 1 second,	Place the cleaner back on the floor.
Blue light flashes five times with one sound	Failure of front wheel	The front wheel gets stuck and doesn't rotate.	Please check if there are twisters on the small wheels of the front wheel.
Blue light flashes six times with one sound	Failure of ground inspection	There is a problem in the ground inspection.	Please check if the sensing window at the bottom of the device is abnormally shielded.
Blue light flashes seven times with one sound	Low battery	Battery power is extremely low, (but not the critical point of recharge voltage).	Please return the device to the docking station for charging,
Blue light flashes eight times with one sound	Failure of front bumper	The impact switches on the left and right front shells can't be restored.	Please check if the device impact buffer is normal or not.
Blue light flashes nine times with one sound	Failure of main brush	The main brush wheel is overloaded or under loaded.	Please check if there are foreign matters on the main brush hairbrush of the device,
Blue light flashes ten times with one sound	Failure of side brush	The side-sweeper wheel is overloaded or under loaded.	Please check if there are things like hair or cloth twine the side brush.
Blue light flashes eleven times with one sound	Failure of wall sensing	There is a problem with sensing walls inspection.	Please check if the transparent window of the wall inspection is shielded or obstructed by hair and cloth
Blue light flashes twelve times with one sound	Failure of fan	The fan doesn't rotate but with large current.	Please check if the blades of the fan are loose or wrapped by hair and cloth.
Blue light flashes fourteen times with one sound	Failure of charging	The device can't be powered or show the charging state.	Please check if the device is connected with the docking station.
